- New kitchen dishwasher is more efficient saving water & electricity (reduces water usage by 52% annually)
- New ballroom lighting with dimmable fluorescent bulbs
- New sensor operated public restroom faucets will save water
- A rain sensor was installed on our lawn irrigation system this year
- Our guest room showerheads and faucets were updated to low flow during the 2005 overnight room renovation
- E-folio, E-Rooming List, electronic billing, email contracts, banquet menus all online, etc.
- Using pitchers of water in the center of tables with water glasses instead of using bottled water
- Low wattage bulbs in guestrooms
- Energy conservation efforts (turning lights/AC off)
- Recycling newspapers
- Converted to a salt water pool. Saline pools are environmentally friendly, eliminating the need for expensive chemicals. They use only pure, natural salt from the ocean. Using saline eliminates the need to store and handle caustic chemicals like chlorine, rare earth compounds, and other hazardous substances.
- Electronic pay stubs versus paper. Associates must specifically request a paper stub if they want one.
- Replaced guestroom faucet aerators from 2.2 gallons per hour to 1 gallon per minute. This has a potential to reduce water consumption by more than 50%
- New recycling program implemented for all types of batteries, fluorescent lighting and electronics
- Member of On Demand Response under ISO New England grid that allows our hotel to power our building with generator to "give back" energy to the grid under peak demands
