- Office paper made from 50% PCW material
- Water saving shower heads in all guest rooms
- Water conserving 1.6pgf toilets in all guest rooms
- Energy management system automates adjustments to water heating system to maintain maximum energy efficiency
- HVAC in meeting space and restaurant is on a variable air volume system which maximizes energy efficiency
- In the wintertime, we use our cooling towers to cool water in the hotel, enabling us to shut off the chillers and save energy
- Motion sensor and timed light switches in storage rooms
- Sensors and water conserving faucets in all public restrooms
- Florescent lighting throughout hotel
- Laundry ozone system uses less steam and reduces chemical usage
- Partnering with The Chesapeake Bay Trust to have groups make donations in lieu of centerpieces
- Produce for Watertable Restaurant and for banquets is purchased from local, organic sources
- All kitchen fryer oil recycled for bio-diesel fuel
- Coffee service in all hotel outlets and banquets uses recyclable cups from post consumer paper
- Seasonal menus that make use of ingredients from local sources
- All cardboard waste is recycled
- Linen-less buffet tables
- Flip chart paper used in meeting rooms made from PCW material
- Key cards made from 50% PCW material
