BANKING SERVICES

International tourists can go to any Mexican bank to exchange Mexican pesos:

- For an amount up to \$ 1,500 USD per month.
- You must present Original Passport with a Copy for the record.

ATM'S

Mexican banks offer a network of ATM's across the country that can be used to withdraw local currency directly and easily.

COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS

-Most restaurants, stores and other establishments, have electronic payment systems. Tourists can pay for any purchase or service with a debit or credit card without restrictions.

-Some commercial establishments operate as bank correspondents. They may accept up to \$100 USD in cash, as long it is associated with a purchase in the establishment.

HOTELS.

In many hotels tourists can exchange American Dollars for pesos up to \$1,500 USD per month during their stay and presenting their original passport

- All hotels must present their prices in Mexican Pesos

- Tourists may ask at the front desk whether the hotel can offer currency exchange or recommend the location of retail bank , exchange house or nearest ATM.

It is important to note that there is no limit for the number of purchases nor the amount of each individual electronic transaction.

It is recommended that tourists exchange their currency to Mexican Pesos upon arrival.
