CHAMPAGNE

Champagne was the first region to make sparkling wine in any quantity and historically the name Champagne became synonymous with the finest, although Champagne is now responsible for less than 1 bottle in 12 of total world production of all sparkling wine.

Dom Perignon 29950

Probably one of the best champagnes, "Fresh, crystalline and sharp, the first nose reveals a unique vegetal, aquatic world, with hints of white pepper and gardenia. In the mouth the attack is direct, a prelude to a lusty roundness that seems to curl up like a plant. The notes of anis and dried ginger glide over fruit skins (pear and mango), creating an effect that is more tactile than fleshy.

Champagne Louis Roederer "Brut Premier" France 18500

From the outset, Brut Premier affirms its personality and seduction: the texture is full and generous and, in a fairly unexpected way, integrates characteristics of maturity associated with fruitier and more refreshing notes. The wine has a fresh festive finesse. In the mouth, the wine has structure, richness and length. It is a full, complex wine that is both modern and powerful, whilst remaining a great classic.

Champagne Pommery "Brut Royal", France 17950

Elegant and lively. Small assertive notes of red fruits. A rounded, rich, delicate wine that lingers in the mouth. In short, a clean taste with no dryness. A very smooth wine which never wanes on the palate.

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Yellow Label 14950

This champagne is a perfect example of harmony between delicacy and power. Dominated by pinot noir, this wine has a firm structure, rounded with a touch of pinot meunier. Nearly a third of chardonnay gives it the elegance and finesse needed for perfect balance.

Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial 13950

The palate is complex with great depth and a high concentration of candied fruit, ginger bread and vanilla flavors, deliberately made in a soft, light and fresh style.

SPARKLING

Sula Brut, India 2750

This celebratory sparkling wine is made in the true "methode champenoise" style. It is creamy, complex nectar that goes down like a dream. Perfect as an aperitif.

WHITE

CHARDONNAY

Is a variety so governed by the whims of fashion that it has seen considerable changes of style by legion of fans. Until about the mid 1990s, rich, oaky varietals were the height of modishness but this has been followed by a trend towards leaner, more appetizing and definitely less oak-dominated Chardonnays.

Maison Albert Bichot Domaine Long-Depaquit Chablis, France 6950

This Chablis stands for its freshness and citrus notes (grapefruit, lime), long and subtle with a great balance.

Renaissance vin de pays d'Oc, France 2350

Pale yellow color with green tints. The nose reveals aromas of white fruits and citrus. On the palate it is well balanced, fresh and crisp.

Bodega Norton, Mendoza, Argentina 2950

Layered aromas of green apples, peaches, honey and vanilla balance flavors of baked apples, lemon, pineapple and mango. A hint of spiced nuts and a suggestion of toasted oak round out the lingering finish.

Vina Tarapaca, Maipo Valley, Chile 2950

Elegant and fresh - packed with attractive pineapple, citrus, melon and peach flavours.

Baron Philippe de Rothschild 'Maipo Valley', Chile 3250

Golden Colour. Bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits. Complex body, notes of pineapple & toast. Well rounded finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Is the popular vine variety responsible for some of the world's most distinctively aromatic dry white wines. The direct, obvious, easy to appreciate of the Sauvignon Blanc seems to answer a need in modern wine consumers who are perhaps more interested in immediate fruit than subtlety and ageing ability.

Villa Maria 'Private Bin' Marlborough, New-Zealand 5950

Transparent light straw with hints of lime green. A pungent scent of spice with cut grass aromas lifting above the white currant and guava

Grover vineyards 'Art Collection' Nandi Hills, India 2250

This wine has a pleasant refreshing mouth-feel and shows intense floral and grapefruit aromas with hints of guava and dried fruits that brings complexity. The crisp acidity enhances the lingering taste of a well-structured wine.

Sula vineyards, India 2250

This wine is herbaceous, crisp and dry with hints of green pepper and a touch of spice at the finish. This wine is well balanced with good acidity.

RIESLING

Has for long been arguably the world most undervalued grape. Riesling is the great vine variety of Germany and could claim to be finest white grape variety in the world on the basis of the longevity of its wines.

Dr.Loosen 'Dr L' Bernkastel, Mosel, Germany 4950

A pale hue. Fresh, floral, mineral and chalky on the nose. It has a nice style. On the palate it is plump, with decent and fresh acidity, a lovely weight, and a floral chalky character. There is an appealing, talcy, chalky finish.

PINOT GRIGIO

Is an immensely popular varietal and the common Italian name for the French vine variety Pinot Gris. The Pinot grigio style of Italy is a light-bodied, often lean wine that is light in color with sometimes spritzy flavors that can be crisp and acidic

Marchesi de' Frescobaldi 'Danzante' IGT, Tuscany, Italy 4450

This dry white wine has an intense bouquet with enticing fragrance of fresh citrus fruits and flowers. On the palate it is silky, with a well balanced body enhanced by hints of pineapple, grapefruit and spices that carry through to a crisp, dry finish

Castello Banfi 'Le Rime' Pinot Grigio & Chardonnay IGT, Tuscany, Italy 5250

Le Rime, pale straw in color, is an aromatic, fruity white wine with a crisp finish replete with refreshing acidity.

Rhone Varietals

Is a variety of white wine grape that is related to the red grape Grenache. It is mostly found in Rhône wine blends and in northeast Spain. Grenache blanc responds best to low fermentation temperatures which produces a fresh, dill scented wine in its youth. The grape is fairly flexible in winemaking and can be exposed to malolactic fermentation, extended skin maceration, lees stirring as well as oak aging. In addition to being blended with Roussanne, Grenache blanc is sometimes blended with Muscat and made in a varietal style

Maison Albert Bichot Cotes du Rhone, France 3250

There's a nice creamy feel to this wine, with melon, butter and yellow apple flavors. Long and rich finish with papaya, almond butter and caramelized figs flavors.

Grover Vineyards Art Collection Shiraz Rose, Nandi Hills, India. 2250

Raspberry pink in color with shades of orange. It has delicate aromas of rose with wonderful flavors of cherry and strawberry jam. Well structured with a dry finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The world's most renowned red wine grape, rivaled only by Merlot as the world's most-planted dark skinned grape variety. From its power base in Bordeaux, where it is almost invariably blended with other grapes, it has been taken up in other French wine regions and in much of the old and new worlds where it has been planted with traditional native varieties and often use to produce pure varietal wine.

Baron Philippe de Rothschild Mouton Cadet AOC Bordeaux, France 5950

Crushed strawberry and raspberry on the nose. The palate is smooth and fresh with elegant and round tannins.

Grover vineyards 'La Reserve', Nandi Hills, India 2550

A beautiful blend of 80% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Shiraz. The wine is pure, rich and focused on a beam of ripe plum, cherry and currant, with touches of anise and cedar. Deliciously complex, deep and persistent, ending with ripples of rich creamy flavors and subtle tannins.

Baron Philippe De Rothschild Cabernet, Bordeaux, France 3950

Deeply coloured with a cherry tint, the wine has a nicely open, ample and concentrated nose that reveals black berry fruit and some intense liquorice and cherry-stone notes, enhanced by a refined and elegant touch of chocolate.

Maison Albert Bichot Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2750

Medium-bodied, with tight flavors of berry and red plum, followed by tobacco notes red cherry and cinnamon, followed by a crisp, straightforward finish.

Renaissance vin de pays d'Oc, France 2650

Dark red colour. Rich and flavoursome on the nose: red fruits, spices, pepper. Full and rich on the palate with elegant tannins. A full-bodied wine.

Vina Tarapaca, Maipo Valley, Chile 2950

Aromas of chocolate and spice are subtle. The palate is complex with ripe fruit being balanced by some drying tannins. The finish is soft and rich.

Baron Philippe De Rothschild Maipo Valley, Chile 3750

The taste is fresh and elegant, with round and soft tannins; the wine is well balance. The long finish. Aromas of blackcurrants, blackberries and blue berries.

Grover vineyards Art Collection Cabernet-Shiraz, Nandi Hills, India 2250

A blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Shiraz. Dense, concentrated, firm and structured, with a core of earthy currant and sage, slowly unfolding to offer greater depth and focus.

MERLOT & MALBEC

Black grape variety originally associated with the great wines of St-Emilion and Pomerol in the Bordeaux region of France. DNA profiling by Austrian researchers provided evidence that Merlot is likely to be the progeny of Cabernet Franc, the other parent being unknown. In consequence, Merlot turns out to be the probable half-brother of Cabernet Sauvignon, which helps to explain why Merlot dominant red Bordeaux can taste like Cabernet dominant wines.

Maison Albert Bichot Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2950

Bold, rich and concentrated, with ripe currant, blackberry cedar and spice aromas that fill out on the palate, ending with firm but ripe tannins and a rich mocha notes.

Marchesi de' Frescobaldi 'Danzante' IGT, Tuscany, Italy 4250

Intense violet red in colour. The open bouquet releases aromas of blackcurrants, blueberries and soft spices. On the palate the wine is soft and persistent with flavours of forest berries and has a long and balanced finish.

Bodega Norton Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina	2950
The texture is silky smooth and smoky. Aromas of ripe blackberry and dark plum. Flavours of chocolate and coffee. Tannins is discreet and the finish is long.	
Sula Satori Merlot	2250
A medium bodied wine with touches of black cherries and ripe red fruit.	

SYRAH

One of the noblest and most fashionable red wine grape, if nobility is bestowed by an ability to produce serious red wines capable of ageing majestically for decades. His cousin, Shiraz, then known as Scyras, was probably taken from France to Australia in 1832 by James Bubsy. It flourished so obviously that it was rapidly adopted by New South Wales and then the rest of the country.

Maison Albert Bichot Chateau d'Orsan Cotes du Rhone, France	3750
Superrich and intense, yet flesh in texture, with flavors of blackberry, wild berry and spicy, smoky wood that fold into a focused medium-weight finish.	
D'Arenberg Stump Jump Red GSM, Mc Laren Vale, Australia	5250
The nose is full of ripe and juicy red fruits and fresh plums mixed with dark cherry, rhubarb and cardamon. The palate is approachable with juicy fresh red berries, mulberry and a hint of pomegranate. Underlying the generous fruit is a more subtle layer of plum stone, star anise and cinnamon which adds complexity and interest. The soft powdery tannins provide a gentle finish.	
Peter Lehmann 'Clancy's Red' Barossa Valley, South-Australia	5950
Shiraz 54%, Cabernet Sauvignon 29%, Merlot 12%, Cabernet Franc 5% Crimson brick red color. Bouquet of ripe plums, some blackcurrant and violets with just a hint of dusted chocolate. A softly textured, smooth and approachable wine, filled with ripe plum, mulberry and full berry flavors, overlaid by smooth velvety tannins, with hints of black pepper on the back palate.	
Sula Dindori Reserva Shiraz, India	2750
Grown on the red hills of Dindori estate and aged for a year in new oak, elegant and smooth, with lush berry flavours and silky tannins	

SANGIOVESE

Italy's most planted and particularly common in central Italy. Sangiovese is widely thought to be of ancient origins, as the literal translation of its name (blood of Jove) suggests. Wines made from Sangiovese tend to exhibit the grape's naturally high acidity as well as moderate to high tannin content and light color. Blending can have a pronounced effect on enhancing or tempering the wine's quality.

Castello Banfi 'Col di Sasso' Sangiovese & Cabernet Sauvignon IGT, Tuscany, Italy	5250
Ruby red color. Fresh and rich fruity aromas, with hints of raspberry, strawberry, black currant and a gentle note of cherry. The structure is soft with delicate and enjoyable tannins.	
Marchesi de' Frescobaldi 'Pater' IGT, Tuscany, Italy	4550
Lively, clean ruby greets the eye, of notable luminosity. Aromas of ripe fruit immediately emerge, strawberry and blackberry foremost, followed by nicely-focused cherry and a subtle, appealing hint of spice. Smooth and savoury on the palate, it offers up richly-layered flavours, and a crisp acidity that makes for a sinewy, beautifully-constructed wine. A lean, well-focused finish.	
Umani Ronchi Montepulciano Doc, Abruzzi, Italy	3450
Ruby red colour with purple reflections the bouquet is soft and rich with good tannic structure, well balanced and a great finish.	

ZINFANDEL

Is an exotic black grape variety of Croatian origin cultivated predominantly in California that has tended to mirror the giddily changing fashion of the American wine business. Zinfandel vines are quite vigorous and grow best in climates that are warm but not too hot, because grapes may shrivel in hot weather.

Kendall Jackson 'Vintner's Reserve' California, U.S.A	6250
Plum, raspberry and blackberry flavors are supported with solid tannins in this rustic Zinfandel. Sultry cedar and spice accents linger on this captivating, long-finishing wine.	

SAKE

A must try Japanese beverage, fine sake is similar to wine in its potential for serious gourmet appreciation. The taste can range from bone-dry, light and crisp to heavy and slightly sweet, often fruity essences dominate, other times rice based grainy flavours are prevalent. Overall, it is lighter than white wine, more delicate and less fragrant.
