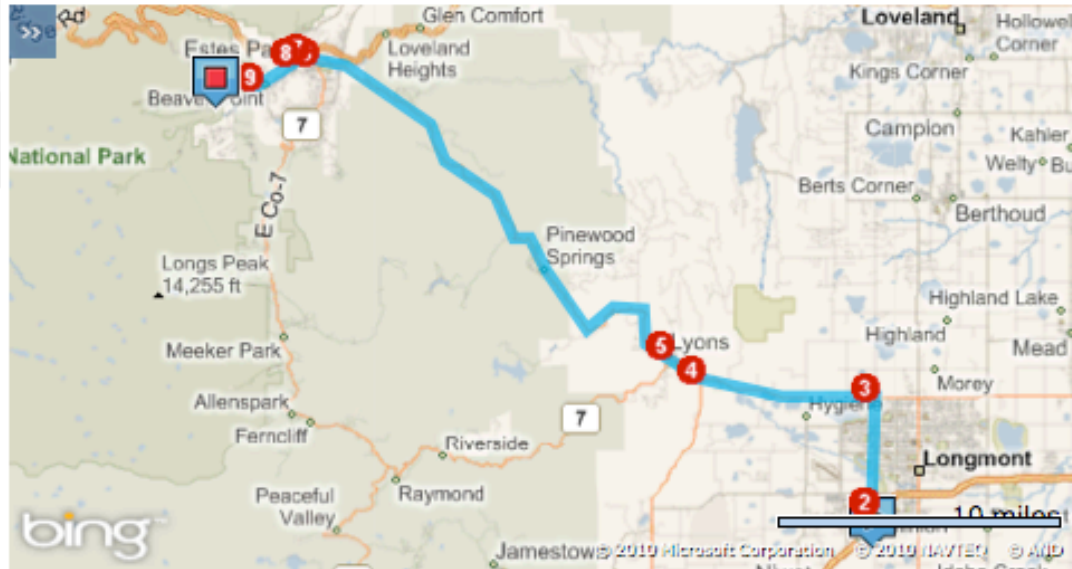

1. Turn right onto Clover Basin Dr	0.2
2. Turn left onto S Hover St / CR-19 North	4.1
3. Turn left onto SR-66 / Ute Hwy	6.4
4. Keep straight onto US-36 / SR-7 / SR-66 / Ute Hwy	1.5
5. Turn right to stay on US-36 West / SR-66 West / W Main St	19.9
6. Keep left to stay on US-36 / St Vrain Ave	0.4
7. Turn left onto US-34 Bus / US-36 / E Elkhorn Ave	0.4
8. Turn left onto US-36 / Moraine Ave	1.7
9. Keep right to stay on US-36 West / Park Entrance Rd	1.7
