LOCAL RULES

1. The R&A Rules of Golf apply.
2. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)
 - a. Any fence forming the boundary of the course.
 - b. The Par 3 course as defined by the white stakes and lines to the right of the 8th and 9th holes.
 - c. The driving range as defined by the white stakes and lines to the right of the 7th hole.
 - d. The maintenance area to the back of the 2nd green and also to the right of the 3rd hole as defined by the white stakes and lines.
 - e. All villa and garden compounds to the left of the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th & 7th holes as defined by the white stakes, lines and boundary walls. NO ENTRY at any time is permitted into the villa and garden compounds.
 - f. The 9th fairway while playing the 1st hole.
3. Water Hazards (Rule 26)
 - a. Water hazards are defined by yellow lines and stakes.
 - b. Lateral water hazards are defined by red lines and stakes.
 - c. Additional drop zones: as an added option where provided, a player may elect to take relief in the dropping zone under penalty of one stroke.
4. Movable Obstructions (Rule 24-1)
 - a. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
5. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)
 - a. All artificial roads and pathways, including the cart path.
 - b. All fixed sprinkler heads and irrigation field units.
 - c. All staked trees.
6. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)
 - a. Any area marked by a continuous white line is defined as GUR from which play is prohibited. If a ball lies in this area or it interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.
7. All sandy waste areas to be treated as 'through the green' as defined in the definitions of the Rules of Golf. The club can be grounded in these areas, as they are not bunkers.
