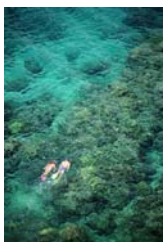

Blow Holes

These natural fountains, created by water tunneling under the shoreline and then bursting up out of the ground, are a sight to behold. When the weather is right, visitors can see the Blow Holes off of Frank Sound Road as they drive towards the eastern end of the island.
