- Directions to Washington DC: 17.9 Miles
- Head southwest on VA-665/Waples Mill Rd toward Lee Jackson Memorial Hwy/US-50 W
- Take the 1st left onto Lee Jackson Memorial Hwy/US-50 E
- Slight left at Fairfax Blvd
- Turn right at Old Lee Hwy
- Continue onto Arlington Blvd/US-50 E
- Merge onto I-66 E/US-50 E via the ramp to Washington
- Entering District of Columbia
