



# DESTINATION KAUA`I

Kaua`i, fourth largest and oldest of the main Hawaiian Islands is a gem of an island, nearly circular in shape, with brilliant highlights of scenic splendor along its 90 miles of coastline and within its rugged interior. The island is 33 miles long and 25 miles wide, comprising an area of 552 square miles.

## KAUA`I BY LAND

**Kaua`i Back Road Tour** - 20 minute drive from hotel

Behind locked gates, Kaua`i Back Road Tour uses four-wheel drive vans on former cane roads, where you will get access to 22,000 acres of Grove Farm Plantation.

Learn the history of Kaua`i as you meander along the scenic back roads, past reservoirs and various crops through a mountain tunnel, to the sparkling beach of Maha`ulepu, also visiting the Old Koloa Sugar Mill along the way.

**Kipu Ranch Adventures - 20 minute drive from hotel**

Ranch & Mountain Tour 3 hours: The most popular tour traverses through the diverse landscape that makes Kipu Ranch one of the top eco-tour locations in the world. The views on the Ranch Tour include the incredible view of Kipu Kai from the top of the mountain, through the forest and along the Hule'ia River to the "Indiana Jones Swing". Many movies have been filmed on the Kipu Ranch and the ranch tour takes you to some of those locations. Abundant wildlife is sure to be seen. Whether you're a first-time or a seasonal rider, you'll love the scenery and trails!

**Kauai Backcountry Adventures – Tubing - 10 minute drive from hotel**

Transverse Lihue's old sugar plantation into Kauai's pristine emerald green interior and enjoy breathtaking vistas and spectacular scenery. Learn about the plantation era, local culture, tropical plant and animal life as you journey to the start of your tubing adventure. Then, hop in your tube and enjoy lush scenery as you float down a historic waterway. The open channels, flumes and amazing tunnels were hand built circa 1870 by plantation workers. Each tunnel is unique and magical, especially when you and your group turn on your headlamps to view these engineering wonders. After a leisurely float, enjoy a refreshing dip in a natural mountain steam and a delicious picnic lunch, An unforgettable adventure!

## KAUA'I BY OCEAN

The majestic Na Pali Coastline provides some spectacular views above the waterline. Touring by boat is a must do experience because of its vertical cliffs, which create the "Cathedral of the Pacific." You will spot sea caves and watch waterfalls dropping straight into the ocean. None of these wonders are viewable from land. Enjoy the varied marine life, sea turtles, playful spinner dolphins, and humpback whales during whale season (December through April).

Tour Na Pali Coast by Catamaran then a raft shuttle (weather permitting) will pick 15 passengers and bring you to Nu'alolo Kai (beach) for a cultural walking tour of an ancient Hawaiian Village. Lunch is provided when you return to the catamaran along with snorkeling.

## KAUA'I BY RIVER

### **Wailua River** - 15 minute drive from hotel

The kayak tour starts at the mouth of Hawai'i's only navigable river and continues through a sacred valley, measured about 2.5 miles. Upon arriving at a jungle trail, you will hike 1 mile on a pathway used by the ancient Hawaiians. At the end of the trail is a 120 ft. waterfall called Uluwehi Falls or more commonly known as "Secret Falls". Tour is 4.5 to 5 hours. The entire tour consists of 5 miles of kayaking and 2 miles of hiking.

### **Hulei`a River** - 5 minute drive from hotel

This exclusive one-way kayak paddle brings you into the Hule'ia National Wildlife Refuge, home to some of Hawaii's native wetland birds and plants. Witness famous movie locations and historic site such as the Alekoko (Menuhune) Fishpond. Enjoy light snacks in the shade of mango trees along the shore of the river. At the end of your paddle, you will take short nature-walk along a forest trail to waiting air-conditioned vans. Here our guides will take you on a short van ride to your ultimate destination, two secluded, private waterfalls! At the trail head, you will be given bottle water and start a 10 minute jungle hike down a trail cut into the hillside. The forest is abundant with guava, passion fruit, Laua'e fern, noni fruit and more. Your first stop will be at Bamboo Falls for a short break of pictures, talk story, laugh and have fun! The best part, it is your own private paradise! After 30 minutes or so, we'll dry-off; gather our things and start the 15 minute hike back out to our picnic area. Here you will wrap up your journey with a gourmet deli lunch in the shade of our 'Picnic Hale' on a bluff overlooking the Hule'ia Valley. The drive back will stop at the Fishpond lookout for another beautiful bird's eye view of the river and the valley.
