HOW TO FIND US

London Zoo is in the north-east corner of Regent's Park, London, near to Camden Town and Madame Tussauds. London Zoo is outside of the congestion charge zone.

By tube

Camden Town (Northern Line):
10 min. walk - follow signs to London Zoo or
catch a 274 bus towards Baker Street (5 min. bus)
Regent's Park (Bakerloo Line):
20 min. walk - follow signs through Regent's Park
Baker Street (Bakerloo Line):
15 min. bus - Catch a 274 bus towards Camden Town

Parking (car & coach)

London Zoo runs a car park on the Outer Circle road in Regent's Park, 500 metres from the Zoo gate.
Coach parking: £40 per coach per day.
Group organisers visiting London Zoo receive £20 cash back at the car park on presentation of zoo tickets after their visit.
Car parking: £7 per car per day.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNING

Come face to face with the hairiest, scariest, tallest and smallest animals, right in the heart of London. With over 5000 amazing animals in 36 hectares of beautiful gardens and heritage-listed buildings, London Zoo is a great excuse for a Big Day Out!

Group activity: Illustrated Talk in English

Students can find out how the role of a modern zoo has evolved from the collecting, research and display of exotic and wild animals in Victorian times to active participation in the preservation of endangered species and wildlife conservation. The talk will be conducted by a Zoo Education officer, and will take place in the Education Centre.

Duration: 40 minutes

Price: £2.00 per head with a London Zoo ticket (must be pre-booked 14 days in advance)

Group activity: English Language Trail

London Zoo has designed a great way for students to experience this historical zoo and develop their English Language skills at the same time. The Zoo at Work is a safari trail that has been developed as a self-guided educational experience perfect for students studying the English. Students follow the trail and answer a series of questions about as they make their way through the zoo, visiting animals and key landmarks across the site. The trail allows students to pick up new vocabulary, converse with members of Zoo staff and complete comprehension exercises.

Duration: Approximately 1.5 hours

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

On arrival at London Zoo main gate, your group should go to the fast-track Group Sales ticket desk with a pre-bought voucher or ticket. Allow 3 – 4 hours for a full zoo visit including a safari trail, but allow 40 minutes longer if you book the illustrated talk.
