LIGHT, FRESH AND CRISP WHITES

Cullinan View Chenin Blanc - Robertson, South Africa 2008/9	20.50
<i>The grape which has put South Africa on the world wine map. You may find apple, nut and citrus flavours.</i>	
Montemarino Pinot Grigio - Veneto, Italy 2008/9	21.00
<i>A firm favourite, produced just outside Verona. Refreshing pear and citrus notes.</i>	
Sun Tree Catarratto - Sicily 2008/9	18.00
<i>Clean and fruity, but not too heavy - a really easy to drink wine with lovely ripe peach on the palate</i>	
Emporium Sauvignon Blanc - Venezia, Italy 2008/9	21.00
<i>A finer, more subtle style of Sauvignon than most New World examples. Delicate and Balanced.</i>	

FULLER FLAVOURED, DRY WHITES

Melbourne Lounge Chardonnay-Pinot Grigio - SE Australia 2007/8	26.00
<i>A wine made for sharing; fragrant and relaxed in style - all soft nectarines and zesty citrus fruits.</i>	
Macon Villages, Louis Jadot - Burgundy, France 2007/8	32.00
<i>A concentrated wine that is also clean and minerally, a result of the care given to the estate's old vines.</i>	

AROMATIC AND FRUITY UNOAKED WHITES

Errazuriz Sauvignon Blanc - Casablanca Valley, Chile 2008/9	26.00
<i>From an ancient estate comes this thoroughly up-to-date, lively wine with fresh fruit salad aromas.</i>	
Sancerre, La Fuzelle, Adrien Maréchal - Loire, France 2007/8	38.00
<i>Discovered by trendy Parisians' in the 1950's, this is now a classic wine. Really fine, zesty and perfumed.</i>	
Vidal Estate Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough, New Zealand 2008/9	32.00
<i>Benchmark wine from arguably the best area in the world for Sauvignon. Classic gooseberry and passion fruit.</i>	
La Campagne Viognier - VdP d'Oc, France 2007/8	21.00
<i>This Viognier (pron. Vee-on-ee-ay) has refreshing apricot fruit notes and a rounded mouth feel.</i>	
Emporium Chardonnay - Sicily 2008/9	21.50
<i>We simply had to buy this wine when we tasted it. Tropical fruits and notes of mandarin.</i>	
Hardys Riesling-Gewürztraminer, The Riddle - SE Australia 2008/9	20.00
<i>A really versatile wine, and medium dry in style. Difficult to pronounce, so easy to drink.</i>	

FULL FLAVOURED, RICH OAK-AGED WHITES

Kleine Zalze Barrel Fermented Chenin Blanc - Stellenbosch, South Africa 2008/9	25.00
<i>This is a special wine made from Kleine Zalze's best vineyard plots and enhanced by the creaminess of oak fermentation.</i>	
Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Chardonnay - California 2007/8	28.00
<i>Mondavi was the pioneer of California wine. This example is satisfyingly reminiscent of peaches and cream.</i>	

RED WINE

LIGHT FRUITY REDS

Côtes du Rhône, La Dentelière - Rhône, France 2007/8 21.00
A simple, satisfying red displaying warm summer fruits. Produced around the rolling hills of Northern Provence.

Sun Tree Cabernet - Veneto, Italy 2008/9 18.00
Smooth and juicy, hints of blackcurrant. A wine that slips down effortlessly. 4.50

Emporium Shiraz - Sicily 2008/9 21.00
More freshness and subtlety than the super-rich style of New World Shiraz. 5.00

Munro Pinot Noir - Veneto, Italy 2008/9 22.50
The Pinot Noir grape is ideally suited to lighter style reds. Silky smooth with flavours of wild strawberry. 5.50

MEDIUM BODIED DISTINCTIVE REDS

Faustino VII Rioja Tinto - Rioja, Spain 2006/7 28.00
Ever popular wine from Northern Spain's Rioja district. Warm fruit flavours and earthy notes.

Errazuriz Merlot - Curicó Valley, Chile 2007/8 28.00
A velvety and satisfying wine from Chile's premier family run wine estate. Partially aged in oak.

Melbourne Lounge Cabernet-Merlot - South Eastern Australia 2006/7 26.00
Chic and stylish, laid back wine that combines soft plum and vanilla flavours. 6.00

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Vigne Nuove, Valle Reale - Italy 2006/7 29.00
Surrounded by a National Park forest, this estate produces Italy's most respected Montepulciano.

Kleine Zalze Pinotage - Stellenbosch, South Africa 2007/8 22.95
South Africa's own grape be a little rustic, but here is just oozes with charm and and fresh fruit character.

RICH, SPICY AND RUSTIC REDS

Villa Bruccio Primitivo-Negroamaro - Puglia, Italy 2008/9 21.00
From the heel of Italy, a red produced using the local version of the Zinfandel grape, Primitivo. 5.00

Veramonte Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon - Colchagua, Chile 2007/8 28.00
Vermonte's low yielding vineyards produces a deep coloured, aromatic wine with real blackcurrant flavours.

Fetzer Vineyards Shiraz - California 2007/8 27.50
An un-oaked Shiraz that brims with fruit intensity and a hint of liquorice. From one of California's greenest producers.

FULL FLAVOURED, MELLOW AND SMOOTH REDS

Boschendal 1685 Shiraz - Coastal Region, South Africa 2007/8 32.00
Loved by anyone who has this beautiful estate, just outside Stellenbosch. Spicy blackberry and vanilla notes.

Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon - California 2007/8 28.00
So mellow and warm, with very ripe berry fruit flavours. Full but not too rich. 6.50

Raimat Tempranillo - Costers del Segre, Spain 2004/5 26.00
Here in eastern Spain, Australian winemaker Mark Nairn uses Tempranillo (the Rioja grape) to make an oaky masterpiece.

Tintara, Horseshoe Row Cabernet Sauvignon - South Australia 2005/6 26.00
A lovely mouthful of silky wine that just slips down. Ripe blackberry, nutty oak and great richness.

DESSERT WINE

Muscat de Beaume de Venise - Rhône, France 26.00
One of the few wines in the world that tastes of grapes, as well as honey and marmalade.

ROSE WINE

Montemarino Pinot Grigio Rosé - Veneto, Italy 2008/9 21.00
Made in a medium dry style, showing soft strawberry fruit. The colour is a delicate pale pink. 5.00

Sun Tree Merlot Rosé - Veneto, Italy 2008/9 18.00
A dry, fantastically versatile wine (great with food or on its own) that brims with red fruit flavours.

SPARKLING WINE

Codorniu Clásico 1872 Brut, Cava - Spain NV 27.00
The family-owned house of Codorniu has winemaking roots dating back to 1551. Their Cava's are some of the best around.

Pinot Grigio, Cuvée Rose Brut, San Orsola - Italy NV 26.00
Fun-filled pale pink fizz that is brimming with fun and flavour.

CHAMPAGNE

Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut NV 78.00
Bollinger's style is rich but dry, very full and mature.

Dom Pérignon Brut 2000 170.00
Iconic, complex and simply the best. When nothing else will do.

Piper-Heidsieck Brut NV 48.00
Multi-award winning Champagne with is highly complex in flavour and wonderfully balanced. 10.00

Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial NV 64.00
Deservedly famous Champagne that continues to improve. Balanced, fresh, soft but dry.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV 71.00
Only one quality, the finest, will do for this house. Deeply flavoured yet zesty and crisp.
