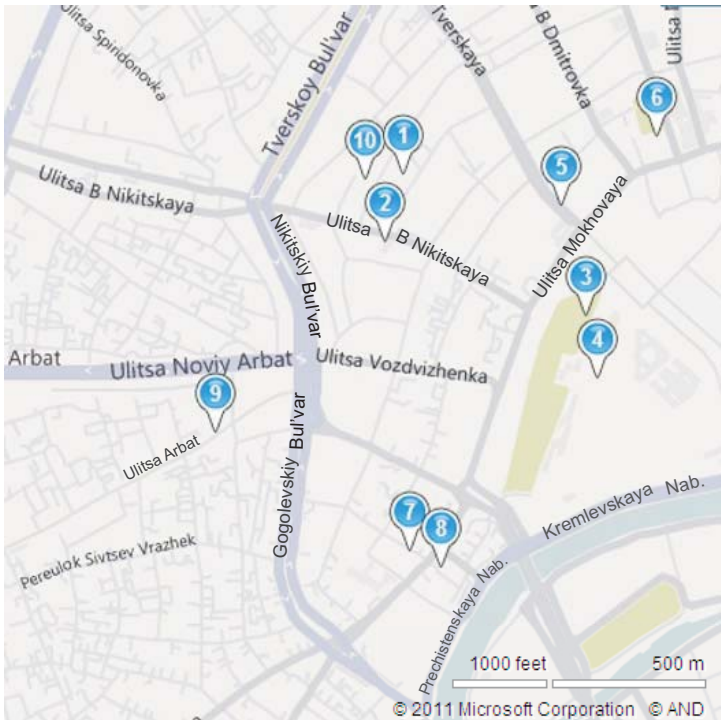


MOSCOW in one day

How: Start off by walking.

① **St. Andrew's Anglican Church**

Take a few steps out of the hotel and you'll face the famous St. Andrew's Anglican Church, standing on the opposite side of Voznesenskiy Pereulok. This is the sole Anglican Church in Moscow and one of only three in Russia.

② **Tchaikovsky Moscow Conservatory**

Continue your way right across the Voznesenskiy Pereulok and then turn left to the Bolshaia Nikitskaya Street. Take a few steps down the street, and you'll see the second oldest conservatory in Russia and one of the leading music universities in the country.

③ **The Red Square**

Walk about 500 meters more, and in 5 minutes a gorgeous 400 by 150 metres square will open up to your eyes. The Red Square lies in the heart of Moscow and on its four sides stand the Kremlin, GUM Department Store, State Historical Museum and St. Basil's Cathedral - centers of government, commerce, history and religion.

4 The Moscow Kremlin

You can enter the Kremlin right from the Red Square through the beautiful Troitskie or Borovitskie gateways. A gorgeous historical complex will open to you its famous cathedrals, palaces, museums and other edifices, which combine to reflect the glory and splendour of Russia through the ages.

5 Tverskaya Street

On the opposite side of the Red Square you will see the most famous street of the city, Tverskaya street. Hundreds of boutiques and shops, cafes and restaurants, bars and night clubs, business centers and luxury living apartments are located on one of the longest central streets of Moscow. You can go up the street and explore the heart of the city life or walk further by the Mokhovaia street right to the famous Bolshoi Theatre.

6 The Bolshoi Theatre

The greatest world ballet and opera performances are held in this historic theatre. The Bolshoi Ballet and Bolshoi Opera are respectively amongst the oldest and greatest ballet and opera companies of the world. The theatre is the parent company of The Bolshoi Ballet Academy, a world-leading school of ballet.

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7 Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts

If you go back down the Mokhovaia street to the beautiful Kremlevskaya and Prechistenskaya embankments, don't miss the famous Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts, the largest museum of European art in Moscow.

8 Cathedral of Christ the Savior

The famous Cathedral of Christ the Savior is located just opposite the Pushkin Museum. It is the tallest Orthodox church in the world and respectively one of the most beautiful Moscow cathedrals.

9 The Arbat Street

You can continue your way along the lovely central boulevards up to the Arbat, the oldest surviving street of the Russian capital. Walking by its historical buildings you will meet many people selling souvenirs, traditional food, clothes, etc., as well as artists, musicians and other curious characters.

10 Carry your way up across the Gogolevskiy and Nikitskiy boulevards and turn right to Bolshaia Nikitskaya street. Walk about 250 meters right, then turn left to the Voznesenskiy Pereulok. Take a few steps more, and you're back in the hotel.

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
