



PARIS COLOMBES

FROM OUR HOTEL TO THE CATHEDRAL NOTRE DAME DE PARIS

Opening hours: The cathedral is open everyday from 8:00AM to 6:45PM except between 12:30PM and 2PM on Saturdays

Entrance fees: Access to the Cathedral is free of charge /Access to the Crypt is 3.30€ (free under 13) / Access to the Towers is 8 € (free under 18) /Audio guides are available for 5 euros

Mess Schedule:

From Mondays to Saturdays: 8:00am, 9:00am, 12noon, 5:45pm and 6:15pm (6:30pm on Saturdays)

Sundays: 8.30am, 10:00am, 11:30am in English, 12:45pm and 6:30pm

➤ **BY TRAIN:** About 35 minutes / Travel fees: about 4€

Walk out of the hotel & keep walking straight on the **boulevard Charles de Gaulle** on 400 meters. Cross the bridge over the railway & turn on your left. Walk straight on the street **Rue de l'Arrivée** to La Garenne-Colombes train station.

Take the train **Direction Paris Saint-Lazare**.

Departures every 10 to 15 minutes from 5:00AM to midnight

Get off at: **GARE SAINT-LAZARE**

Buy a Metro ticket from a machine or at any RATP counter.

Take the **METRO 14 Direction Olympiades**

Departures every 3 minutes from 5:30AM to 0:30 (1:30AM on Friday & Saturday evenings)

Get off at: **CHATELET**

Take the street **Rue Saint-Denis** and walk to the square/ plaza **Place du Châtelet**. On your left follow the quay **Quai de Gesvres** and keep walking on the side of the river Seine till the bridge **Pont Notre Dame** on your right. Cross the bridge and keep walking on the street **Rue de la Cité**. The cathedral is at the end of the street on your left.

➤ **BY TAXI:** Around 12.5km. Taxi G7 Rate: about 25 minutes / Price: around 25€
