Let the Renaissance Paris Le Parc Trocadero Hotel be your peaceful haven in one of the most prestigious neighborhoods of Paris: near the Champs-Élysées, the Eiffel Tower and the Paris Congress Center. The Hotel reflects pure elegance and refinement while maintaining the atmosphere of old Paris.

The Hotel is composed of four different buildings located around the courtyard of 1.200 sqm. In the 1850s, the building at the back of the garden now called "Residence" was first a convent and then a stable belonging to an owner who lived in the turret. A pulley for lifting bales of straw is still visible on the facade of the building.

Built in 1912, the first building, situated at 55-57 avenue Raymond Poincaré quickly became a unique and privileged residence for the elite of Parisian Society.

The two « Anglo-Normand » buildings once housed the bronze and glass-making workshop of the famous wrought iron craftsman Baguès.

In 1986, 3 glass floors were added to the main building.

Under management contract with the Marriott Group since August 1, 2007, the Hotel became a property of the Westmont Group in late 2009. In April 2011, the Renaissance Paris Le Parc Trocadero Hotel reopened with a 5-star rating after 4 months of renovation and offers 100 elegant bedrooms and 22 suites, 5 function rooms, 1 fitness center, a restaurant and a Gin bar set around an enchanting garden brimming with magnolias, tree ferns from Tasmania, Japanese maples...

The Bistro Chic "Le Relais du Parc" offers a simple and tasty cuisine that will remind you of delicious family meals and convivial moments shared with friends. The garden is an invitation to relaxation and the best place to have a peaceful lunch or a moonlit dinner.

The designer, Jean-Philippe Nuel, has taken his inspiration from the building's unique architecture as well as from the Renaissance Brand identity. His mission was to preserve the traditional feel of the building while transmitting a sense of place and culture. The layout of the garden, realized by Philippe Niez, is mirrored in the Hotel's outward appearance as well as in the interior design.

An elegant and sophisticated style emanates from the subtle association of soft and warm colors: white, grey and taupe with touches of gold and mahogany. The designer has chosen refined textures: bright and smooth, soft and transparent, comfortable and cozy.

The new decor is not only rooted in the past but also branches out to embrace the bold lines of contemporary Paris. Moreover, this interplay and contrast create a feeling of warmth and timeless luxury.

The juxtaposition of the existing classical French style of the hotel with its contemporary Parisian interior design touches, associated with remodeling of the existing courtyard, gives a new experience to guests and a distinct identity to this Hotel.

The hotel earned the « Interior Design of the Year for Bedrooms and Bathrooms » at the « European Hotel Design Awards » which took place in London in November 2011.
