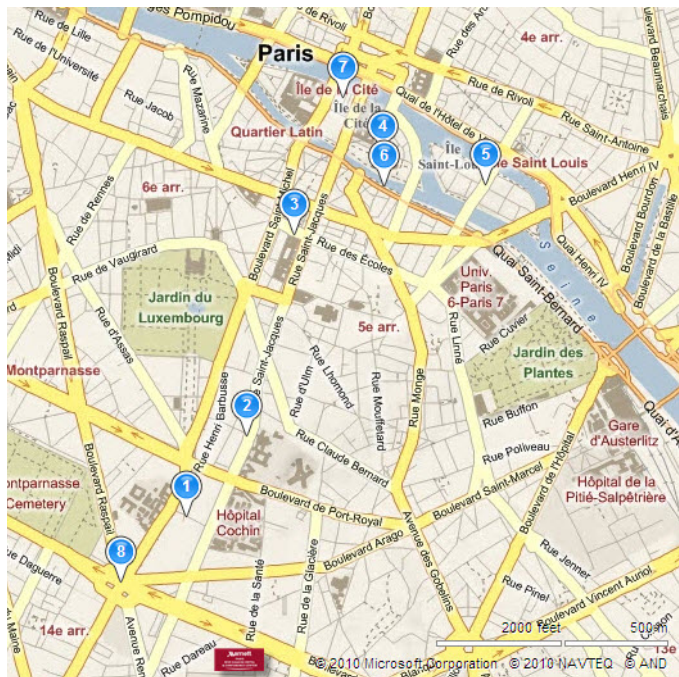

3 HOUR TOUR TO NOTRE DAME AND BACK

- 1 Exit LEFT out of the hotel, turn Right onto Rue du Faubourg Saint Jacques. On the way is the Observatory of Paris to the left, from the 17th reservations required.
- 2 Continue onto Rue Saint Jacques then off to the right is the Church Val de Grâce, built in 1643.
- 3 Next up the Sorbonne the first University in France built in the Middle Ages. .
- 4 Continue on Rue Saint Jacques to the Seine River take the Le Petit Pont Bridge to Notre Dame Cathedral open daily.
- 5 Notre Dame is situated on City Island. Pass behind the cathedral to cross over St Louis Bridge to arrive at the St. Louis Island on the other side of bridge is the famous ice cream parlor, Berthillon.
- 6 Great spot for dining is Bouteille d'Or a lovely French restaurant in front of the Cathedral open daily.
- 7 To return to the hotel, take Metro Cité, cross in front of the Notre Dame Cathedral continue straight to the Metro, take line 4 in the direction of Porte d'Orléans.
- 8 Take the Denfert Rochereau exit; turn right onto Blvd Saint Jacques walk 7 min down the Blvd Marriott will be on your right.
