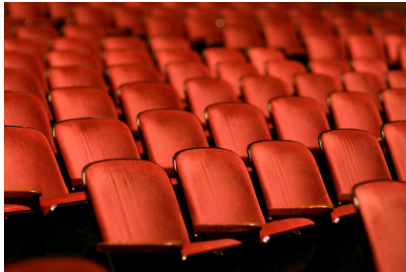

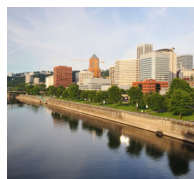
### Portland Spirit & Jet Boats
