A warm, satisfying red from the rolling hills of Northern Provence. 5.10 21.00

– Curico – Chile 2009/10
Very impressive wine from a family estate. Enticing mulberry and oak flavours. 5.10 21.00
- 22 **Fleurie, Domaine de Prion** – Beaujolais – France 2009/10
This elegant wine, made using Gamay, has cherry and redcurrant flavours. 31.00
- 23 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir “Couvent des Jacobins”
Louis Jadot** – France 2007/8
Silky textured, with fresh fruit aromas. Enjoyable with or without food. 8.00 31.00
- 24 **Marchesini Cabernet, Veneto** – Italy 2009/10
Delicate style of Cabernet with warm redcurrant fruit and hints of cherry. 5.10 21.00
- 25 **Munro Pinot Noir** – Italy 2009/10
Pinot Noir shines in lighter style reds. Silky with flavours of wild strawberry. 22.00

Juicy Rounded Reds

- 25 **Faustino VII Rioja Tinto** – Spain 2008/9
Ever popular wine from Northern Spain's Rioja district.
Warm fruit flavours and earthy notes. 25.00
- 26 **Mill Cellars Shiraz** – Australia 2009/10
Bursting with juicy, peppery fruit, so vibrant and easy to drink. 5.10 21.00
- 27 **Errazuriz Merlot** – Chile 2009/10
A velvety, fruity oaked wine from Chile's premier family-run wine estate. 6.50 24.50
- 28 **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Valle Reale** – Italy 2009/10
Sited within a National Park forest, this is Italy's most respected Montepulciano. 25.00
- 29 **Kleine Zalze Pinotage** – South Africa 2009/10
South Africa's own grape be a little rustic, but here it just oozes with charm and fresh fruit character. 21.00
- 30 **Fetzer Vineyards Shiraz** – USA 2008/9
An un-oaked Shiraz that brims with fruit intensity and a hint of liquorice.
From one of California's greenest producers. 24.00

Smooth Spicy Reds

- 31 **Villa Bruccio Primitivo-Negroamaro** – Italy 2010/11
From the heel of Italy, a red produced using the local version of the Zinfandel grape, Primitivo. 21.00
- 32 **Veramonte Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon** – Chile 2008/9
Veramonte's low yielding vineyards produces a deep coloured, aromatic wine with real blackcurrant flavours. 6.25 22.50
- 33 **Raimat Tempranillo Costers del Segre** – Spain 2007/8
Australian winemaker Mark Nairn uses Tempranillo in this oaky masterpiece. 6.50 24.00
- 34 **Ravenswood Lodi County Old Vine Zinfandel** – USA 2007/8
"No Wimpy Wines" is Ravenswood's motto. Deep vanilla notes add complexity. 26.00
- 35 **Domaine de la Baume Syrah “La Jeunesse”
Pays d'Oc** – France 2010/2011
Intense nose of blackberry, spices, almonds and oak. Succulent, polished and long. 25.00

Full Mellow Reds

- 36 **Barbera d'Alba, Suculé, Domini Villa Lanata**
– Italy 2007/8
A rich single estate concentrated Barbera from North West Italy's Piemonte region.
Is that a hint of dark chocolate on the finish? 33.50
- 37 **Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon**
– USA 2009/10
So mellow and warm, with very ripe berry fruit flavours. Full but not too rich. 6.50 25.00
- 38 **Château Lamothe-Cissac Cru Bourgeois**
– Haut Médoc, France 2004/5
It's rare to be able to offer a mature Bordeaux from such a well respected Chateau.
Hints of cedarwood and redcurrant. 29.50
- 39 **Etchart Privado Malbec, Valle de Cafayate**
– Argentina 2010/11
A great match for beef thanks to its richness of fruit, mellow oak and ripe tannins. 22.00
- 40 **Louis Eschenauer Merlot, Pays d'Oc** – France 2010/11
Supple and mellow with perfumed blackcurrent and cocoa aromas. 5.10 21.00
- 41 **Don Jacobo Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Corral**
– Spain 2004/5
Charmingly soft and mature red that is taking on subtle layers of fruit and even hints of leather and mushrooms. 33.00

 Mature biscuity style, deep Pinot flavours balanced by crisp citrus notes.

51 **Piper-Heidsieck Brut NV** 10.50 43.00
 Multi award winning Champagne, rich and full flavoured yet very fresh.

53 **Lanson Brut Rosé Label NV** 11.00 45.00
