

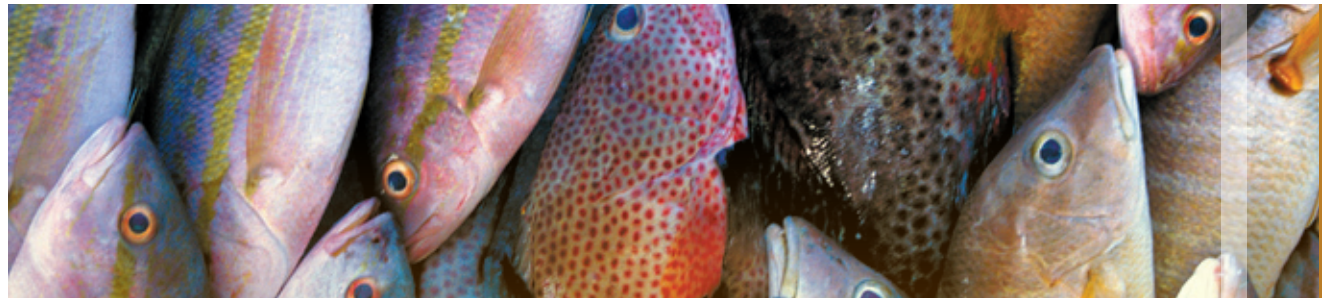


MALLORCA IN FIGURES

| <i>Palma Cathedral</i> | The Gothic cathedral, also called The Seo, was built on the site of an existing Arab mosque from 1230 to 1601. The building, which was begun under the reign of Jaime I, consists of a single plan with three naves. |
| <i>Castillo Bellver</i> | The unique, entirely round castle was finished in 1309. Three large towers surround a central courtyard, connected by an arch to a free standing keep. For many centuries the castle was used as a prison and contains now Palma's museum of municipal history. |
| <i>Tren de Sóller</i> | The Sóller railway connects the city of Palma and the small town of Sóller since 1912. The train has completely retained its original character and the journey leads through beautiful landscapes. |

Frederic Chopin and George Sand spent the winter of 1838 in a former monk's cell in the Carthusian monastery of Valldemossa. The novelist George Sand wrote the book "Winter in Majorca" during their stay.

ACTIVITIES

Mallorca with its sandy beaches and the Serra of Tramuntana, the highest mountain range on the island, offers a wide variety of possibilities to enjoy all types of activities.

Aquacity, Marinland and Palma Aquarium are only some of the theme parks on the island. Boat tours, submarine excursion, safaris along the island, horse riding, karting, diving, climbing and excursions in the mountains are very popular. In addition, nature reserves like Sa Dragonera, S'Albufera de Mallorca and Maritime and Terrestrial national park of Cabrera are often highlights during a visit on the island.

AIRPORT SON SANT JOAN PALMA DE MALLORCA (PMI)

The airport is located 8 km from the city of Palma. In Spain only the airports in Madrid and Barcelona are bigger than the one in Mallorca. Germany represents the largest number of passengers, followed by Spain and the United Kingdom. The maximum capacity of passengers is 25 million. In 2009 the passenger traffic resulted in 21.203.041. Many direct flights connect the island with the Spanish mainland and other main European destinations.
