During the month of July, the Renaissance Jaragua Hotel & Casino and the Courtyard by Marriott Santo Domingo have begun a new internship program jointly with the National School for the Deaf. This program has been designed for the hearing impaired who can develop skills and knowledge in several operational areas of the hotels, giving them an opportunity in a future to be part of a company in the hospitality industry and integrate more into the community they live in.

This internship program has initiated with 9 trainees, distributed as follows: six (6) at the Renaissance Jaragua Hotel & Casino and three (3) at the Courtyard by Marriott Santo Domingo. During a one month period, these students will receive training in areas such as Housekeeping, Laundry, Steward and Purchasing-Storage. At the end of the internship, those who have developed strong skills in their areas will be future candidates for working positions in both properties. In order to give continuity to this project, new trainees will be received on a monthly basis and they will be located in different areas of the hotels.

This is an additional contribution to the activities both hotels develop during the year and is an important part of our Spirit to Serve the Community in Santo Domingo. With this project Marriott International maintains its commitment in the Dominican Republic to take care of the community where its hotels are present.
