

MT. TAMALPAIS STATE PARK (MTSP) HIKE SCHEDULE - 3rd Quarter 2007

M MODERATE SUNDAY HIKES are 7 to 9-1/2 miles, over hilly, rocky terrain, up to a 2,200' elevation gain and are quick paced.

F FASTER SUNDAY HIKES Strenuous, aerobic, fast paced hike, 10 to 14 miles, with up to a 3500' elevation gain.
