Mission San Jose and Museum

Founded in 1797, Mission San Jose is the fourteenth of the 21 Spanish Missions dedicated in Alta California. The mission was originally named La Mision del Gloriosissimo Patriarch San Jose in honor of St. Joseph. The current structure was originally built in 1809 but was severely damaged by the earthquake of 1868 and recently renovated in 1985.
