Old San Juan

Designated as UNESCO World Heritage sites in 1983, the city of Old San Juan and the three forts that have protected the island since the 1600s offers some of the best examples of Spanish fortification and architecture in the Americas. In Old San Juan you can visit the oldest governor's mansion in the Americas at La Fortaleza or view some of the old wooden gates that have kept invaders out of the city. Bioluminescent Bays

Vieques and Culebra Islands

These Islands off Puerto Rico's mainland are known for their unspoiled beauty and pristine beaches, and now are home to large nature reserves. Culebra was home to the first bird sanctuary created by President Teddy Roosevelt. Vieques also has beautiful beaches, but is best known for its Bioluminescent Bays and wild horse population.
