### Top 10 Things To Do Near the St. Kitts Marriott Resort & The Royal Beach Casino

Situated in between the Atlantic Ocean and the Caribbean Sea, St. Kitts' tropical rainforest and stunning beaches provide a memorable setting for you to enjoy this Caribbean paradise. At the St. Kitts Marriott Resort & The Royal Beach Casino, you will be able to relax or find island adventures that will create lasting memories. #### Featured Attraction

##### St. Kitts Scenic Railway

On the narrow gauged tracks that once took the sugar cane from the fields to the mill, the St. Kitts Scenic Railway now offers one of the most beautiful train rides in the world around the island of St. Kitts. The double-decked railcars have an open air observation platform so you can have a 360 degree view of the island. The 3-hour tour offers scenic views of the island villages, sugar cane fields, black sand beaches, and great views of surrounding islands and Mt. Liamuiga. #### Cockleshell Bay Beach

Located on the southeastern tip of St. Kitts next to Banana Bay, the pristine white sand of Cockleshell Bay faces the sister island of Nevis. This beach offers sun and seclusion in a natural setting, along with the amenities of restaurants and bars. Cockleshell Bay Beach is perfect for relaxing in the sun, having a picnic or going for a swim.

#### Mount Liamuiga

With a peak rising to 3,792 feet above sea level, Mt. Liamuiga offers a picturesque panoramic view of St. Kitts and the neighboring islands. At the peak you can also peer into the crater of the volcano that formed this mountain. The hike up Mt. Liamuiga is strenuous and requires a guide, so be prepared.

#### Day Trip to Nevis

A simple 35-minute ferry ride will take you to St. Kitts' sister island, Nevis, where you can enjoy the secluded beaches, water sports, history or Botanical Gardens on a day trip. The coral reefs around Nevis offer a perfect place for snorkeling or scuba diving and Nevis is the birthplace of U.S. Founding Father Alexander Hamilton.

#### St. Kitts Scuba Diving and Snorkeling

Whether taking a boat to a secluded cove or reef or just swimming from a beach, St. Kitts' clear waters offer a fantastic chance for scuba divers or snorkelers of all levels to experience the reefs and marine life in the waters. There are also shipwrecks like the River Taw, which *Skin Diver Magazine* has called one of the best in the Caribbean, to be explored.

#### St. Kitts Sailing

With great trade winds coming off the Atlantic Ocean, St. Kitts and Nevis is the perfect place to go sailing and catch magnificent views of the islands. Sailors will find many adventures to be had, such as a trip over to Nevis or a loop around St. Kitts. Visit remote areas of the islands while having an adventure on the sea.

#### South Frigate Bay Beach

Just a 10 to 15 minute walk from the Marriott or a 3 minute taxi ride will take guests to one of St. Kitts' most popular beaches. South Frigate Bay Beach's calm waters offer a great opportunity to snorkel and enjoy the Caribbean Sea side of the island. At night this beach transforms into one of the island's hotspots with a series of casual bars and restaurants offering live music and entertainment.

#### Brimstone Hill Fortress

Known as the "Gibraltar of the West Indies," the Brimstone Hill Fortress was built on the western coast by the British in 1690. The fort protected St. Kitts and its sugar trade, but changed hands between the French and British many times until it was abandoned in the late 1800s. After becoming a National Park in 1965, the site is now recognized by UNESCO as a "World Heritage Site."

#### Sky Safaris

Located in Old Road Village on the Wingfield Estate, Sky Safaris allows you to fly over St. Kitts' rain forests on a zip line, providing visitors with scenic views of the area's luscious forest and rivers. Sky Safaris features 5 different zip lines that measure from 140 feet long to "The Boss", which is 1,350 feet long and as high as 250 feet.

#### Royal St. Kitts Golf Club
