## Things to Do in St. Louis

### St. Louis Zoo

Considered one of the top zoos in the country, the St. Louis Zoo is home to more than 18,000 exotic animals. Watch apes, elephants, penguins, and others in their natural settings. ## Grant's Farm

Encounter exciting animals and experience a piece of history while visiting Grant's Farm. Explore two of president Ulysses S. Grant's homes: the formal plantation home known as White Haven and Hardscrabble, the hand-built log cabin. Among pieces of U.S. history guests can ride on the tram and observe amazing wildlife preserves including elephants, bird shows, the famous Budweiser Clydesdales, and a kid friendly petting zoo.

## The Muny

Visit the nation's largest and oldest outdoor theater, the Municipal Opera. Located in Forest Park, it provides entertaining free shows including dramas, operas, ballets, and more! Available on a first-come, first-serve basis there are nearly 1,500 seats for every performance.



## World Bird Sanctuary
