The Princeton Marriott now has the highest dedicated bandwidth of any hotel meeting facility in the Tri-State region.

**THE NEED FOR SPEED**

The new six T1 lines can be used throughout the conference center for wireless applications or dedicated hard line service for web-based applications in need of extra bandwidth.

Whether groups need VPN connection, specific IP Pooling, networking, or just accessing the Internet, the hotel's onsite Event Technology staff assures that meeting planners' need for speed is entirely satisfied.

## THE MEETING CENTER

The Princeton Marriott Hotel and Conference Center at Forrestal is certified by the International Association of Conference Centers (IACC). IACC certified conference centers have to meet stringent criteria (including dedicated conference space, availability of meeting packages, ergonomic design of the conference facilities, availability of professional staff, food and beverage requirements, guest room and technology requirements, etc.) and are therefore set apart from other meeting facilities.

Since the property was initially designed and constructed to be a conference center, the overall layout and flow is very conducive to group learning and accomplishment. With all meeting space situated on one floor in a separate wing connected to the hotel, there are an abundance of breakout rooms clustered near larger conference rooms which allow for a wide variety of meeting types. No matter what the group size, privacy is attainable. There are solid walls with tackable wall surfaces and separate entrances to the meeting rooms as well as access to outdoor common areas, refreshment kiosks where attendees can grab a coffee, juice, or quick snack any time throughout the meeting day, providing the flexibility conference attendees desire.

Overall, the property features a total of 32 meeting rooms with 35,000 square feet of meeting space. The largest room is the Alexander Room at 5,000 square feet with a maximum seating capacity of 400.

Conference dining, the Spa, and other recreational facilities are in a separate portion of the building so meetings are distraction free.
