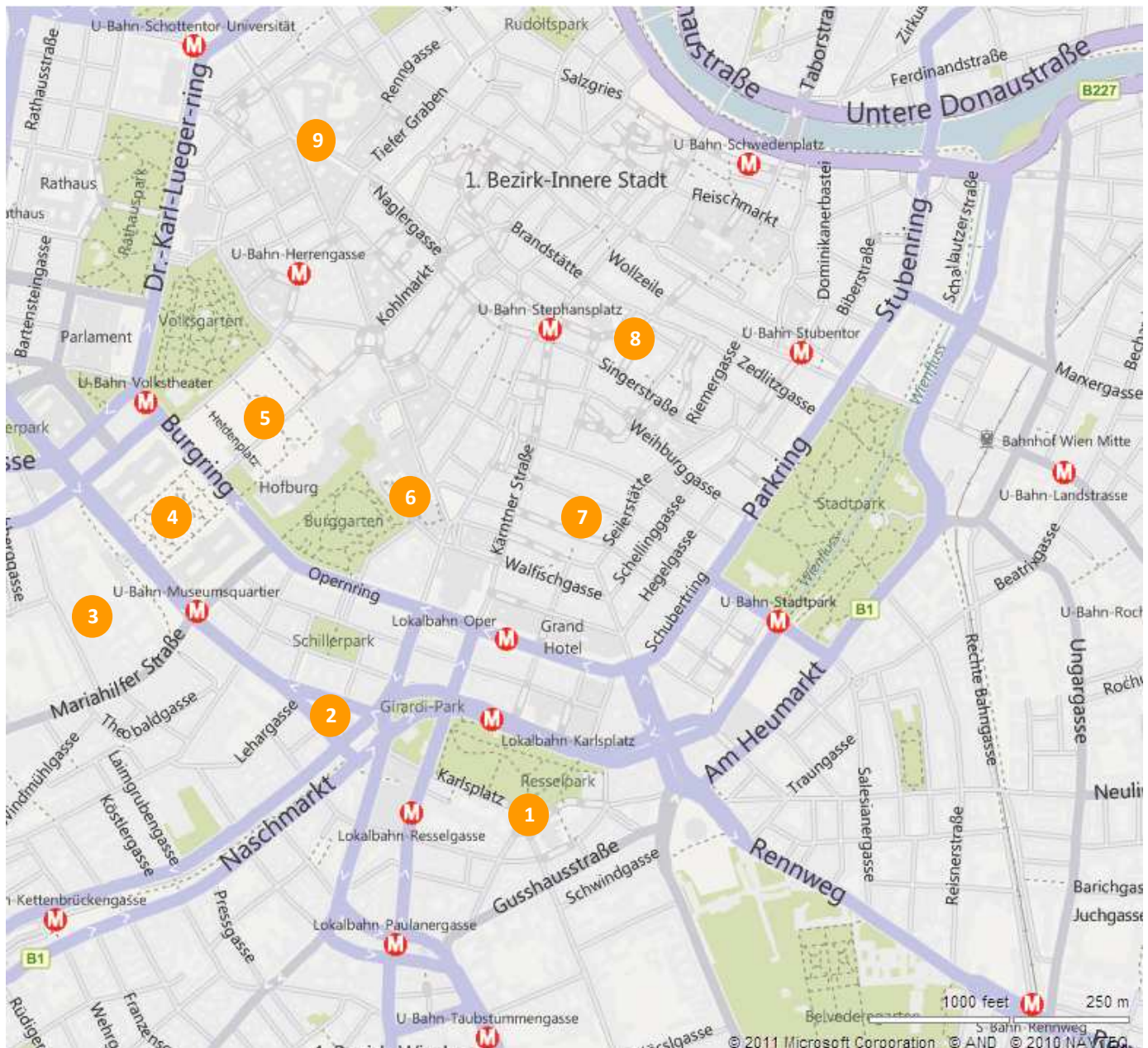

1 Wien-Museum

The Wien Museum has an exceptional position in the rich landscape of the Viennese museums: Its collections are a blend of art and history that leads the visitor down Vienna's path through the centuries.

2 Secession

The Vienna Secession is an exhibition Hall for Contemporary Art founded by the famous artist Gustav Klimt.

3 Museumsquartier (MQ)

The MuseumsQuartier Wien is one of the largest cultural complexes in the world and offers about 60,000 square meters of space for modern and contemporary art and culture. It is an oasis of culture and recreation, with courtyards, outdoor restaurants, cafés, and shops.

4 Kunsthistorisches & Naturhistorisches Museum (Museum of Fine Arts & Natural History)

The museums of fine arts and natural history are one of the most important museums of the world. They were built to find a suitable shelter for the Habsburgs' art collection and to make it accessible to the general public.

5 Hofburg (Imperial Palace) and Sisi Museum

The Vienna Hofburg is a must for anybody wanting to explore the world of the Habsburgs and Austrian history. The Sisi Museum provides authentic insights into the life and personality of Empress Elisabeth. The exhibition presents Sisi's true personality in a sensitive exploration of the empress's life and fate.

6 Albertina

This neo-classical house accommodates one of the finest art collections in the world. Visit great exhibitions with classic and contemporary art.

7 Haus der Musik (House of Music)

The "Haus der Musik" is an interactive discovery museum located in the heart of Vienna's first district. A host of interactive installations playfully communicate openness to new things, understanding and enthusiasm in approaching music.

8 Mozarthaus

The apartment in Domgasse 5 is the only one of Mozart's apartments in Vienna that still exists today. The life and work of this musical genius are presented in and around this apartment on four exhibition levels.

9 Kunstforum

The Kunstforum is the top address for art lovers, especially for classical modern painting of the post-war years.
