Resort Recycle Program - The resort partners with Waste Management to provide recycling resources for paper, plastic, aluminum, cardboard, fluorescent and other mercury containing lamps.

LEED Certified - Registered with the U.S Green Building Council and certified under USGBC's LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) program.

TPC San Antonio - Our PGA TOUR golf facility is designed for water conservation, featuring a closed loop irrigation system that catches water run-off for reuse with a vision that has been certified by the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program.

River Bluff Water Experience - All pools were designed with a special filtration system that uses 80% less water for cleaning and flushing.

Low VOC Paint and Glue - The resort utilizes all low VOC products.

Smart Air Conditioners - The climate systems in all guest rooms features a "smart system" recognizing when exterior doors are open and automatically shutting down to conserve energy.

Refillable Dispensers - The Resort now utilizes refillable soap, shampoo and conditioner dispensers in all guest rooms, eliminating single use plastic bottles.

Bird Sanctuary - Established in a 150 acre tract north of the golf courses as a safe haven for the endangered Golden Cheek Warbler.

Beehives - The food and beverage team and Culinary Gardener are responsible for providing regional bees with the home they need to thrive by maintaining beehives on the resort's property and harvesting honey from them.

JWSA Conservation Series - Partnerships with Desert Door and Fretail Brewing Co. allows the Resort to create a positive impact in the local community and work collaboratively to help protect our Texas bees.
