At Lisbon Marriott Hotel, we aim to reduce food waste by 50% and water and energy consumption by 3% by the end of 2025. We target a 50% reduction in our carbon footprint by 2030 and plan to increase volunteer hours by 50% during 2025, driving a more sustainable future.

SUSTAINABILITY IN EVENTS

- Refillable water stations in the Executive Lounge to reduce single-use bottles
- Collaborating with ReFood to collect and distribute leftover food to those in need
- Use of cage-free eggs and prioritization of local and certified sustainable products
- Implementation of Winnow food waste monitoring system with AI-powered technology
- Containers and bags for waste separation with respective colors used for correct and effective waste separation
- Serving 100% fair-trade tea and juices in glass dispensers
- Growing herbs in our garden to support fresh and sustainable food offerings
- Prohibiting the consumption of fish from endangered species through our sustainable fish policy

SUSTAINABILITY IN GUEST ROOMS

- Energy-efficient mini-bars in all rooms
- Water-saving fixtures: dual flush systems and shower flow rates under 8L/min
- Amenities provided through refillable dispensers (shampoo, conditioner, shower gel) to avoid single-use plastics
- Digital formats for guest information (mobile dining with QR code)
- Uniforms made with ecological fibers and use of eco-certified cleaning products without chlorine
- Smart HVAC control systems for optimal temperature management (18°–22°)

ENERGY & WATER CONSERVATION

- 75% of the hotel equipped with LED lighting
- Heat recovery systems connected to refrigeration and ventilation networks
- Motion sensors installed in all bathrooms for efficient lighting
- Energy-efficient equipment prioritized for all new purchases
- Water-saving measures: bathroom flow rates under 5L/min in public areas, urinals with automatic flush sensors, new dishwashers using less than 3.5L per cycle
- Replacement of the plumbing system to improve consumption and heat efficiency
- 6 electric car charging stations installed in the garage and electricity supplied by renewable energy sources
