

CHRISTMAS MARKET AT MARIENPLATZ

The Christmas Market at Marienplatz, a traditional market dating back to the 14th century, is considered the original among Munich's Christmas markets. Set against the romantic backdrop of the neo-Gothic Town Hall on Marienplatz, this market exudes a special charm. The market with its Bavarian charm invites visitors to savor the Christmas season with all their senses. Bavarian parlor music, brass bands, and choirs perform live daily from the Town Hall balcony to set the mood for the upcoming holidays.

MEDIEVAL CHRISTMAS MARKET

At Wittelsbacherplatz, history comes alive. Immerse yourself in a charming Christmas market that transports you to a bygone era, where dozens of carefully crafted wooden stalls bring the atmosphere of the Middle Ages back to life. Here, individuals in authentic historical attire present their goods, and at practically every corner, visitors can marvel at the fascinating arts of ancient craftsmanship.

PINK CHRISTMAS QUEER CHRISTMAS MARKET

During the Advent season, the small Stephansplatz in the heart of Munich's Glockenbachviertel district turns pink. The LGBTQ* community's Christkindlmarkt, which has been held since 2005, welcomes a diverse audience with mulled wine, gifts, delicious treats, and sparkling lights. The small stage features drag artists, up-and-coming singers, and even renowned performers like Grand Prix legend Johnny Logan or pop star Patrick Lindner. It's a small but uniquely different Christmas market.

MUNICH'S FEUERZANGEN-BOWLE

Munich's Feuerzangenbowle at Isartor is once again a hot spot this winter. The punch, a fragrant blend of red wine, rum, and spices, is poured from a massive kettle with a crown of flames. Each year features a joint exhibition with the history workshop and other partners. Food and drink are also well catered for.



TOLLWOOD WINTER FESTIVAL AT THERESIEN-WIESE

The Tollwood Winter Festival bathes Theresienwiese in a sea of lights. Typical for this alternative Christmas market is the blend of delicious organic food and a wealth of original arts and crafts at the „Market of Ideas.“ Most events, ranging from theater to music and performances, as well as environmental activities and a diverse children's program, are free of charge.

NEUHAUSER CHRISTMAS MARKET

Immerse yourself in the festive atmosphere of the Neuhauser Christmas Market at Rotkreuzplatz. Here, you'll find everything your heart desires, from traditional Christmas tree decorations and artistic nativity figurines to handcrafted soaps, beeswax candles, gloves, and much more. In addition to the rich offerings, an engaging event program awaits you, featuring Punch and Judy shows, a Christmas goose raffle, and soulful music.

SCHWABINGER CHRISTMAS MARKET

For over 40 years, artists and restaurateurs have delighted visitors at Münchner Freiheit in Schwabing with an atmospheric Christmas market filled with loving details and gift ideas. Alongside culinary delights, this year's Christmas market offers an art tent, a sculpture trail with installations, free concerts, performances, guided tours, and activities for children. There's a special and unique atmosphere here.



CHRISTMAS MARKET AT THE CHINESE TOWER

From the Chinese Tower, the Christmas melodies of the tower musicians waft down, and horse-drawn carriages leisurely make their rounds. In the wintry English Garden, half-hidden under ancient chestnut trees, the lights of the romantic market stalls glitter and sparkle. At the stalls, lambskin slippers, handmade dolls, and little wooden angels await new owners who can also recharge with waffles or Kaiserschmarrn.
