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THE STORY OF 1906

A raging flood in May 1903, is credited with the founding of Overland Park. The widowed mother of William B. Strang asked him to leave his home on Park Avenue in New York City and come rescue her from the misery of the flood's aftermath. Strang made his way to Kansas City and took his mother down South to a farm owned by a friend.

Upon her arrival, she commented to her son how fresh the air smelled and how happy she was to get out of the grimy city. Her comment helped spark Strang's plan to build a park-like suburb there, with fresh air and no chance of flooding. By 1906 Strang had platted his new community of Overland Park and had also constructed an interurban rail line which would provide the new residents with reliable transportation north to downtown Kansas City and south to Olathe.

Over the ensuing decades Strang's vision of a suburban community would grow to become the largest city in Johnson County and the second largest city in the State of Kansas.
