Bar

From coffee specialties with a selection of fresh cakes in the afternoon from 2:30 p.m. to delicious cocktails in the evening until 0:30 a.m., our bar team, Sven and Rico, are here to take care of you.

Beauty farm

Our beauty farm team is available at the following times: Daily from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., Christmas Eve/New Year's Eve from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., closed on December 25 and January 1. We recommend booking appointments in advance.

Dogs

We ask for your understanding that dogs are not allowed in the restaurants and in the pool/sauna area — except at the bar, the Josefistube and the Spitzing Alm. In the lobby or the Josefistube, we will also serve you food on request if you do not want to leave your pet alone in the room. Further information on dog etiquette can be found on your dog flyer, which you will receive upon arrival. Dog shower: At the end of the garage in the upper part, there is a dog shower with a hairdryer for your four-legged friend.

Fitness room

Our fitness room is accessible via the 100 hallway and is open around the clock, 24/7. Children under the age of 16 are only permitted to enter when accompanied by an adult. Thank you for understanding.

Game rental

Ski lift

The Alpine ski lifts take you via the Stümpfling chairlift to the beautiful mountain world around Spitzingsee! You can find out the operating hours at reception as well as buying tickets for skiing at the front desk.

Ski passes

On request, we will be happy to provide you with day passes or 4-hour ski passes, valid throughout the Alpenplus area.

with ski boot heater is located in the garage (no liability for items brought in).

Smoking lounge

Despite the smoking ban in Bavaria, you can enjoy your cigar or cigarettes here. However, the law does not allow us to serve food and drinks there. We ask for your understanding.

SPA area

Opening hours for the saltwater thermal baths from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. We ask for your understanding that during the midday rest period from 12:30 p.m. to 3 p.m., children under the age of 12 are not permitted!

Opening hours for the sauna area with relaxation room from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to enter, as it is a place of rest. Thank you for understanding.

Toboggans

Free rental of classic wooden toboggans at the reception desk — we kindly ask for a deposit and that you return them daily.

Wildlife feeding

As soon as there is a closed snow cover, the red deer in the Spitzingsee area are fed. During the Christmas season, there is a daily feeding show. The Spitzingsee professional hunter accompanies you every day from 3:30 p.m to the wildlife feeding. The meeting point is at the gate in Valepp, heading in the direction towards the "Blecksteinhaus". Please make sure you wear warm clothing. Binoculars are recommended.
