## **DAY 1**

### **NOON**

Drop your bags off, freshen up a little with a cold towel, and take a stroll along Poppies Lane. Walk on foot or rent a bike and explore the hidden alleys that connects Kuta Beach street to Legian district, from tiny eateries and boutique coffee shops to ponder in, used book store to fulfill your vintage needs, to surf shops where you can customize your boards. Make sure to spot the colorful graffiti murals for your Instagrammable moments – think Melbourne's Hosier Lane, but in paradise.

### **AFTERNOON**

After all that exploring, now is the time to glam up for your night out on the island. Located on Beachwalk's top floor, Rob Peetoom offers immaculate hair cuts and treatments. ## **DAY 2**

### **MORNING**

If you have a soft spot for animals, go and visit the Bali Sea Turtle Society on the Kuta Beach strip, an organization running a conservation program for endangered sea turtles. They relocate the eggs from the beach to a central hatchery to protect them and increase hatching rates. The eggs take up to 60 days to develop and hatch, once hatched, they'll release them back into the ocean. If you're lucky, you might just witness a turtle release!

### **NOON**

Time to release your inner daredevil at 5GX Bali: Reverse Bungy. Located just across Sky Garden, this adrenaline pumping activity is a must do for those who have the guts. You and two others will be put into a metal ball that will then catapult you up high into the sky, spinning and bouncing. Worry not, designed and developed in New Zealand, the team of 5X really makes sure of the safety of its passengers. Have fun and don't forget to scream at the top of your lungs for the GoPro video that will be documenting your wild ride.

## AFTERNOON

### NOON
