City Tour: Colonial and Modern Lima

Pachacamac, Barranco and Chorrillos

This park is the pride of Lima and has been recognized as the largest Water Fountain Park in the world by the Guinness Book of World Records. At the end of the tour we will stop at a famous restaurant in Miraflores to enjoy a buffet dinner and spectacular show of traditional folk dances from the Coast, Sierra and Jungle of Peru.
