### Devils Chair IPA, Florida \$6

"A SINISTER PUNCH OF BRIGHT, FRUITY HOPS AND A DRY, BITTER FINISH THAT WON'T LET GO! LEGEND HAS IT THAT IF AN UNOPENED CAN OF BEER IS PLACED ON THE DEVIL'S CHAIR IN CASSADAGA, FLORIDA AT MIDNIGHT, IT WILL BE EMPTY THE NEXT MORNING."

### Sunburnt, Ireland \$7

"A TRADITIONAL IRISH STYLE WITH A TWIST, IT HAS SUBTLE CARAMEL NOTES BALANCED WITH A PLEASANT FRAGRANT AROMA FROM NEW ZEALAND AND AUSTRALIAN HOPS. GOES REALLY WELL WITH ROAST BEEF, LAMB OR A TRADITIONAL IRISH STEW, BUT BEWARE: KEEP OUT OF DIRECT SUNLIGHT."

### Jai Alai, Tampa \$7

"SOFT BREADINESS SUPPORTS AN INTENSE TROPICAL BOUQUET OF ORANGE, TANGERINE, MELON AND A TOUCH OF PINE. LIKEWISE, THE BRIGHT, PLAYFUL SWALLOW SENDS A FRESH, FRUITY BLEND OF GRAPEFRUIT, PEACH, MELON AND TANGERINE ACROSS THE TONGUE, BACKED BY LIGHT GRAINY BREAD NOTES. GENTLE BITTERNESS CLEANS UP THE SWALLOW, RESULTING IN A SMOOTH FINISH."

### Stella Artois \$6

"THIS SOPHISTICATED BELGIAN BEER HAS A WELL-BALANCED FLAVOR PROFILE – PLEASANTLY BITTER WITH A REFRESHING FINISH – THAT MAKES IT EXTREMELY VERSATILE AND A GREAT PAIRING FOR DISHES FROM AROUND THE WORLD."

### Smithwick's Ale \$6

"IRELAND'S NUMBER ONE ALE. ITS EXCEPTIONAL TASTE, THE AROMA IS VERY MILD. THERE'S AN OVERLAYING MALTY SWEETNESS. SOME VERY SUBTLE HINTS AT NUT AND ROASTED GRAINS, WHICH ARE ONLY SUBTLY RECOGNIZABLE AFTER LETTING THE BEER WARM UP, AND THERE IS LITTLE IF ANY PRESENCE OF HOPS."

### Guinness \$6

"MADE FROM WATER, BARLEY, ROAST MALT EXTRACT, HOPS, AND BREWER'S YEAST. A PORTION OF THE BARLEY IS ROASTED TO GIVE GUINNESS ITS DARK COLOR AND CHARACTERISTIC TASTE. IT IS PASTEURIZED AND FILTERED."

### Islamorada \$7

"A SIMPLY BREWED CITRUS ALE THAT IS JUST WHAT THE "DOCTOR" ORDERED FOR A HOT DAY IN THE SUN. IT IS THE PERFECT RECIPE OF HOPS AND NATURAL CITRUS FLAVORS THAT WILL GET YOU BACK ON YOUR FEET AND INTO THE NEAREST BOAT. THE IDEAL COMPLEMENT FOR A LONG DAY OF ISLAND RUNNING."

### Yuengling \$

"TRADITIONAL LAGER IS AN AMERICAN LAGER FAMOUS FOR ITS RICH AMBER COLOR AND MEDIUM-BODIED FLAVOR. BREWED WITH ROASTED CARAMEL MALT FOR A SUBTLE SWEETNESS AND A COMBINATION OF CLUSTER AND CASCADE HOPS

### Full Irish, Ireland \$7

"HOPPY FRUIT TASTING BEER WITH A BISCUITY MALT BODY. AFTERTASTE: ROUNDED BITTERNESS THAT CLEANSSES THE PALATE WITH A LINGERING SWEETNESS FROM THE SINGLE MALT PREPARING THE PALATE FOR THE NEXT SIP. AROMAS OF HOPS. THIS HOP BOMB HAS AROMAS OF CITRUS AND FLORAL CHARACTERS, PARTICULARLY GRAPEFRUIT AT THE FORE, HINTS OF LIME, MELON AND LYCHEES."

### Strongbow \$7

"BLEND OF BITTER-SWEET CIDER AND CULINARY APPLES, WITH 50 DIFFERENT VARIETIES OF APPLE USED. THE APPLES ARE GROWN IN ENGLAND AND FRANCE. IT IS MASS-PRODUCED USING MODERN METHODS, AND CONTAINS APPLE CONCENTRATE AND SUGAR. "
