1. Tbilisi Opera and Ballet State Theatre

25, Rustaveli Avenue; Tel: +995 32 214 32 03;

Turn right on the Rustaveli Avenue and in several minutes walk you will see the magnificent Opera building.

2. Rustaveli Theatre

17, Rustaveli Avenue; Tel: +995 32 272 68 68;

Rustaveli Theatre is situated in two minutes walk from the Hotel. Turn right on Rustaveli Street and the second next building to the Hotel will be the beautiful Rustaveli Theatre.

3. Parliament

8, Rustaveli Avenue

Go out of the hotel and turn left. In several meters you will see the parliament building on the opposite side of the street.

4. National Gallery

Go out of the hotel and turn left, cross the Chanturia Street and the next building is the National Gallery.

5. Kashveti Church

Go out of the hotel and turn left, cross the Chanturia Street and next to the National Gallery you will see the Kashveti Church.

6. National Museum of Georgia

Go out of the hotel and turn left. Walk down the Rustaveli Avenue and close to the Freedom Square you will see the museum building.

7. Museum of Fine Arts

1, Gudiashvili Street; Tel: +995 32 299 99 09;

Turn left and walk to the Freedom Square, then take immediate left, the very first building on the right.

8. Freedom Square

Go out of the hotel, turn left and stroll down the Rustaveli Avenue. In several minutes you will see the Freedom Square.

9. Chardin Street (restaurants and cafes)

Turn left and walk to the Freedom Square. Go down the Leselidze Street and in the end of the street on the left you will see the narrow street of Chardin.

10. Abanotubani (Sulfur bath district).

Turn left and walk to the Freedom Square. Go down the Leselidze Street and in the end of the street turn right and you'll see the oldest place in the city and Sulfur Baths.
