

Marriott International is working to reduce its environmental impacts, build and operate sustainable hotels.

GOAL: Reduce environmental footprint by
15% | 30% | 45% | 50% across the portfolio by 2025 (from a 2016 baseline; for
water/carbon/waste/food waste)

Water: Reduce water intensity by 15%

Carbon: Reduce carbon intensity by 30%.

Waste: Reduce waste to landfill by 45%.

Reduce food waste by 50%

Renewable energy: Achieve a minimum of 30% renewable electricity use

The hotel's 'Green Team' work on environmental projects for the hotel and also with other Marriott hotels. We aspire to educate and inspire associates, business partners and guests to conserve and preserve and be more thoughtful towards the environment. Reduce, reuse and recycle when possible.

WATER

Onsite water filtration unit is installed and is used for bottled water in the meeting rooms to eliminate the need for outsourcing bottled water.

M-IQ high efficiency dishwasher installed in the main kitchen.

Efficient planting of shrubs and other plants to reduce the need for regular watering of plants.

CARBON

Associates are encouraged to use public transport and bikes to get to work. Electric car charging station has been installed in the car park.

All equipment when not in use or needed is turned off and unplugged.

WASTE

We have a sustainable waste management online tracking system wherein 100% of all hotel waste is recycled by the waste management company.

VITO cooking oil recycling machine is installed to reduce annual cooking oil usage and labour cost.

All printer toners and cartridges are collected for recycling as well.

ENERGY

All non-essential lights and equipment are turned off at peak times saving energy and costs.

We are working with Schneider energy to reduce energy consumption.

Voltage system has been lowered saving overall energy used by the hotel
