

THE ONE-DAY MINSK TOUR

Minsk city like any other city, has its own unique way. He has the title of "Hero City". Capital is the largest center of the country.

1) Railway Station Square. There is a modern building of the new railway station on one side of the square. The Minsk railway station one of the most comfortable in Europe concerning with opinion of experts. There is the "Gate City" stylized as medieval towers on the other side of the square.



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2) Then we walk down the Kirov Street, where is located the building of the Court of the Eurasian Economic Community. We take a walk to the Mikhailovsky park, where are the marvelous works of Belarusian sculptor Vasiliy Zhbanov.

3) Next, we head to Nezavisimosti Square, it is the main administrative area. There is the Church of Saints Simon and Helena - a monument to the monumental architecture, erected in honor of their parents prematurely dead children. The main avenue of the city starts with this square, this avenue changed its name 14 times and is one of the longest streets in Europe. It is the Nezavisimosti Avenue. You will be welcomed by the most beautiful buildings in the style of Stalin's empire. The notable fact is that the height of buildings to two times less than the width of the avenue.

4) Then we go through Nezavisimosti Avenue to the historic center of Minsk. Svobody Square is the place where you can see the castle site and the Town Hall and the Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Monastery of Jesuits Orthodox Cathedral of the Holy Spirit. Combining multiple religions in one place that is what it means tolerance of the Belarusians.

5) The Trinity suburb, on the "Island of Tears" we can find a symbolic chapel, which is located at the base of the bronze sculptures of grieving mothers, sisters, wives. Do not forget the Minsk's favorite river - Svisloch, along which are very fond of walking residents and visitors.

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
