

THE TWO-DAYS MINSK TOUR

To experience the city's history, learn how the citizens of Minsk have lived, it is best to spend two days exploring Minsk.

1st day. Along Nezavisimosti Avenue.

1) Railway Station Square. There is a modern building of the new railway station on one side of the square. The Minsk railway station one of the most comfortable in Europe concerning with opinion of experts. There is the "Gate City" stylized as medieval towers on the other side of the square.

2) Next, we head to Nezavisimosti Square, it is the main administrative area. There is the Church of Saints Simon and Helena - a monument to the monumental architecture, erected in honor of their parents prematurely dead children. The main avenue of the city starts with this square, this avenue changed its name 14 times and is one of the longest streets in Europe. It is the Nezavisimosti Avenue. You will be welcomed by the most beautiful buildings in the style of Stalin's empire. The notable fact is that the height of buildings to two times less than the width of the avenue.

3) There are many historical and cultural buildings on the Nezavisimosti avenue: the main building of the Belarusian post, Central bookstore, Lakomka - sweet shop, the State Department Store, Palace of the Republic and so on.

4) Moving further along the main street of the city, on the one side we can see the building of the Belarusian State Circus, and there is a large park on the other side, named after one of the most famous classic

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writers of Belarus. It is Yanka Kupala Park. If you go further in the park, you can find a wonderful big white building. This is the National Academic Opera and Ballet Theatre, where you can also go on excursion.

5) Pobedy Square is the one of the most majestic and ceremonial areas of the capital, where is located a monument and the eternal fire.



6) When you reach Yakub Kolas Square, you can get acquainted with another Belarusian writer, and visit the oldest market square of Minsk - Komarovskiy market.

7) It will be wonderful to finish the first day of our tour on the observation platform of the Minsk "diamond". This is National Library of Belarus.

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2nd day. Along the river Svisloch.

1) Loshitsa park. This is an amazing place where you can find centuries-old linden trees, 400 species of plants and animals, as well as the manor and museum. And in order to enliven our walk in the park, you can solve the quest-tour "Loshitsa park."

2) On the way to the historic center of Minsk, we can look to the National Art Museum of Belarus.

3) Then we go to the historic center of Minsk. Svobody Square is the place where you can see the castle site and the Town Hall and the Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Monastery of Jesuits Orthodox Cathedral of the Holy Spirit. Combining multiple religions in one place that is what it means tolerance of the Belarusians.



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4) The Trinity suburb, on the "Island of Tears" we can find a symbolic chapel, which is located at the base of the bronze sculptures of grieving mothers, sisters, wives. Do not forget the Minskians' favorite river - Svisloch, along which are very fond of walking residents and visitors.

5) Pobediteley Avenue will lead us to a new building of the Great Patriotic War Museum.

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
